HOSTETTER

The Hostetter Cemetery is located on the old Isaac Hostetter farm $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles northeast of Frankford, Missouri. It is on a plot of ground east of the family home. It was set aside and fenced by the owner who directed that his grave be the first therein and was to be located in the center of the plot. Isaac Hostetter was born in Pennsylvania in 1770. His father was Ulrich Hostetter a Revolutionary Soldier. Isaac Hostetter came to Missouri by way of Kentucky. He lived a few years at St. Charles, Missouri. Later he moved up the Mississippi River to the mouth of Salt River and then to Peno Creek and made his home in that vicinity the rest of his life.

He was not a preacher but a man of strong religious convictions and it was in this home that the First Christian Church of Frankford, Howard County, Mo., was organized. At the present time there are about 100 graves in the Hostetter Cemetery. There have no new graves in the last 40 years but the cemetery is maintained by a fund contributed by descendants of those who lie therein.

GRAVESTONES MARK TRAVAIL OF PIONEERS

The settlers came from Kentucky, Tennessee and Virginia and it was here they stopped in those years before the Civil war.

Others went on, out of Independence, Kawsmouth and Westport and on to Little Santa Fe, the last stop before the jump across the Great Plains to Santa Fe in the New Mexico territory.

But the settlers stayed on, farming the good land just west of the Blue river at what is now 124th street and Wornall road. Off to the west, Little Santa Fe became New Santa Fe and over the years the "pilgrims" came and went.

The Parents Went on West

One was named William See, son of J. and N. See, and he died near Little Santa Fe, on the way west, July 5, 1849. There was nothing else to do, so they buried William See, aged 19, in the King burying ground east of Little Santa Fe and his parents went on.

Thus William See remained, buried in what the early settlers used instead of a cemetery-a plot of land put aside to bury the young and old in. Frontier life was rude; life was not easy. They made do.

The King burying ground was not a rarity. There were others, such as the knoche plot near Martin City, the Lipscomb

plot near 110th and State Line, the Korby and Ervin plots on Red Bridge road, and the Watts plot near the little settlement of Dallas at 103rd and State Line.

Bulldozers Have Missed Some

Some have been bulldozed away by the advance of what, when the single acre was set aside for the King plot, was the little town of Kansas hard by the bluff along the Missouri river. Some other plots were moved. But William See, age 19, has remained along with the Kings, the Sheltons, the McPherson, the McCraws, the Sharps, the Bargers, and the others who were buried in the small cemetery.

But while the city often destroys, it sometimes reveals. And the graves in the King burying ground now have regular visitors for the first time in 50 years.

The construction of the new Loretto academy at 123rd street and Wornall started this fall. One day, while walking during lunch south of the construction site, some workers found the cemetery, almost grown over by brush and small saplings.

Stones Hard to Read

Of course, others had been at the cemetery in past years. The headstones, most of them faded and almost illegible because limestone was used, have been knocked down, either by wind or vandals.

H. R. Vest, who lives about 100 yards to the northwest of the cemetery, said he had visited the cemetery only a few times since he moved there two years ago.

"The construction of the school opened up all that brushy land," said Vest. "I suppose if they hadn't put the school there, well, that place would still be back in the brush."

The newest markers are 1907-1907. Most of the markers date back in the 1860s, 1870s, 1880s, and 1890s. The land was used for burying since the 1830s and early 1840s, historical records showed.

A barb wire fence surrounds the cemetery, often called Mount Pleasant cemetery in the latter part of the last century. There is no road into the area, only grown-over land.

And in a corner is a marker, summing up the life of Elizabeth Barger, born April 15, 1830, died January 9, 1894. The stone might speak for all the settlers who stayed, watched the wagon trains and other settlers head west and worked the land.

"She died as she lived," said the marker, "trusting in God."

Under an oak tree, the headstone of William King remains where it fell. About 50 persons, most of them early residents of Washington township in Southwestern Jackson County, are buried in the plot. (Picture shows stone reading: William King, died Apr. 3, 1857 aged 69 years, 6 mo's & 8 days.)

FORT OSAGE

A name given to an old fort, known also as Fort Clark and Fort Sibley. It was built on a bluff, a mile from Sibley, on land bought from the Osage Indians, known as the "Six Mile Tract," and now included in Fort Osage Township, Jackson County
